

### Short Bio of Thomas N. Perloff

Thomas N. Perloff studied economics at the University of Pennsylvania, the London School of Economics and Syracuse University. He worked for ten years as the administrator of a multi-specialty primary care practice, Penn Urb Health Associates. Mr. Perloff then joined the family wholesale grocery business and shifted the business from serving retail food stores to institutional foodservice. Tartan Foods evolved into the largest independent foodservice distributor in the Philadelphia market. Upon selling Tartan to Sysco in 1993, Mr. Perloff consulted and taught about foodservice at the Haub Business School of St. Joseph's University. In 2007, he started his "encore career" as Director of Development and Finance at Congregation Rodeph Shalom. He led a capital campaign to restore and expand the historic congregation and helped establish an early learning center, serving the congregation and neighborhood. His commitment to healthcare has continued for forty years as a Trustee of the Albert Einstein Healthcare Network, a safety net healthcare system in Philadelphia
